Confession of Faith:

The Westminster Larger Catechism 23,24 & 25

Pastor: Into what estate did the fall bring mankind?

People: The fall brought mankind into an estate of sin and misery.

Pastor: What is sin?

People: Sin is any want of conformity unto, or transgression of, any law of God, given as a rule to the reasonable creature.

Pastor: Wherein consisteth the sinfulness of that estate whereinto man fell? **People:** The sinfulness of that estate whereinto man fell, consisteth in the guilt of Adam's first sin, the want of that righteousness wherein he was created, and the corruption of his nature, whereby he is utterly indisposed, disabled, and made opposite unto all that is spiritually good, and wholly inclined to all evil, and that continually; which is commonly called Original Sin, and from which do proceed all actual transaressions.

Confession of Sin: Psalm 32

- 1 Blessed is the one whose transgression is forgiven, whose sin is covered.
- 2 Blessed is the man against whom the LORD counts no iniquity, and in whose spirit there is no deceit.
- 3 For when I kept silent, my bones wasted away through my groaning all day long.
- 4 For day and night your hand was heavy upon me; my strength was dried up as by the heat of summer. Selah
- 5 I acknowledged my sin to you, and I did not cover my iniquity; I said, "I will confess my transgressions to the LORD," and you forgave the iniquity of my sin. Selah
- 6 Therefore let everyone who is godly offer prayer to you at a time when you may be found; surely in the rush of great waters, they shall not reach him.
- 7 You are a hiding place for me; you preserve me from trouble; you surround me with shouts of deliverance. Selah
- 8 I will instruct you and teach you in the way you should go; I will counsel you with my eye upon you.

- 9 Be not like a horse or a mule, without understanding, which must be curbed with bit and bridle, or it will not stay near you.
- 10 Many are the sorrows of the wicked, but steadfast love surrounds the one who trusts in the LORD.
- 11 Be glad in the LORD, and rejoice, O righteous, and shout for joy, all you upright in heart!
