Confession of Faith:

*The Westminster Larger Catechism Q. 48-49*

**Pastor:** *How did Christ humble himself in his life?*

**People:** *Christ humbled himself in his life, by subjecting himself to the law, which he perfectly fulfilled; and by conflicting with the indignities of the world, temptations of Satan, and infirmities in his flesh, whether common to the nature of man, or particularly accompanying that his low condition.*

**Pastor:** *How did Christ humble himself in his death?*

**People:** *Christ humbled himself in his death, in that having been betrayed by Judas, forsaken by his disciples, scorned and rejected by the world, condemned by Pilate, and tormented by his persecutors; having also conflicted with the terrors of death, and the powers of darkness, felt and borne the weight of God's wrath, he laid down his life an offering for sin, enduring the painful, shameful, and cursed death of the cross.*

Confession of Sin:

Psalm 51:9–17

9 Hide your face from my sins, and blot out all my iniquities.

**10 Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a right spirit within me.**

11 Cast me not away from your presence, and take not your Holy Spirit from me.

**12 Restore to me the joy of your salvation, and uphold me with a willing spirit.**

13 Then I will teach transgressors your ways, and sinners will return to you.

**14 Deliver me from bloodguiltiness, O God, O God of my salvation, and my tongue will sing aloud of your righteousness.**

15 O Lord, open my lips, and my mouth will declare your praise.

**16 For you will not delight in sacrifice, or I would give it; you will not be pleased with a burnt offering.**

**17 The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit; a broken and contrite heart, O God, you will not despise.**
