**Pastor:** What are the punishments of sin in this world?

**People:** The punishments of sin in this world are either inward, as blindness of mind, a reprobate sense, strong delusions, hardness of heart, horror of conscience, and vile affections; or outward, as the curse of God upon the creatures of our sakes, and all other evils that befall us in our bodies, names, estates, relations, and employments; together with death itself.

Pastor: What are the punishments of sin in the world to come?

**People:** The punishments of sin in the world to come, are everlasting separation from the comfortable presence of God, and most grievous torments in soul and body, without intermission, in hell-fire for ever.

Confession of Sin: Psalm 6

1 O Lord, rebuke me not in your anger, nor discipline me in your wrath.

- 2 Be gracious to me, O Lord, for I am languishing; heal me, O Lord, for my bones are troubled.
- 3 My soul also is greatly troubled. But you, O Lord—how long?
- 4 Turn, O Lord, deliver my life; save me for the sake of your steadfast love.
- 5 For in death there is no remembrance of you; in Sheol who will give you praise?
- 6 I am weary with my moaning; every night I flood my bed with tears; I drench my couch with my weeping.
- 7 My eye wastes away because of grief; it grows weak because of all my foes.
- 8 Depart from me, all you workers of evil, for the Lord has heard the sound of my weeping.

9 The Lord has heard my plea; the Lord accepts my prayer.
